## GENERAL RULES

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

#### GENERAL RULES

- 1 Entry for the Show, except those classes which are open, is confined to persons in the Club area. The Show area covers the parishes of Laggan, Kingussie, Alvie, Rothiemurcus, Duthill, Abernethy, Cromdale, Inverallan, Kirkmichael, Knockando, Inveravon, Aberlour and Mortlach.
- 2 No Member can enter items until all arrears and the current year's subscription have been paid. Admission to the Showfield will be by Member's Badge issued on receipt of subscription.
- 3 All disputes shall be referred to the Special Disputes Committee whose decision shall be final. Whenever possible, the committee shall consider and give their decision on Show day. Notification regarding disputes must be made by written notices as follows:-  
  
By Attending Members immediately following completion of judging of relevant class.  
  
By Exhibitors before 4 pm on day of Show.  
  
In every case the sum of £10 must be lodged along with a letter outlining cause of dispute. In the event of the complaint being upheld by the Committee the £10 deposit will be returned.
- 4 The Judge shall in all cases distribute prize awards in accordance with the number of entries of each class; ie he shall judge the exhibits on their merits and shall not be empowered to withhold any section, class or special prize awards.
- 5 Intending exhibitors must enter on the prescribed form of entry not later than midnight on Thursday 5th July 2012.
- 6 Any Exhibitors infringing any of the foregoing rules may be required to forfeit all prizes won by them at the Show and may be debarred from showing for a period of three years.

#### DOMESTIC RULES

- 1 All entries must be in place by 8:45 am. Exhibits and Prize Money to be collected after 4:30 pm. No exhibits may be removed from the Domestic Sections before 4:30 pm and any exhibits remaining in the Domestic Section after 5 pm remain there at the Exhibitor's risk.
- 2 Baking and horticultural entries to be shown on paper plates.
- 3 The entry fee is 50p per entry up to a maximum of £10.00, ie 4 entries £2.00, 15 entries £7.50, 20 and above entries £10.00.
- 4 All articles in the Arts and Crafts Sections must be home made. For Photographs, the mount will not be judged. Please ensure all drawings and paintings are ready for hanging.
- 5 Entries in Domestic Classes D3 and D4 are limited to one entry per person per class and two entries per person per class in Sections D2 and D5.
- 6 Each Entry must be separately numbered on Entry form. Please copy the form if more entries are required.
- 7 Only Judges and Attending Members are allowed in the marquees during judging.
- 8 No articles in Domestic Sections shall have been exhibited at previous Shows of the Strathspey Farmers' Club.
- 9 No Smoking is allowed in the marquees.

- 10 Although every care will be taken no responsibility can be accepted by the Strathspey Farmers Club for any accident or loss that may befall exhibits.
- 11 In Domestic Classes, except where otherwise stated, where there are seven or eight entries, prize money of equivalent value to the third prize in the appropriate class will be given to the fourth prize winner as well as the usual prize ticket. Where there are nine or more entries, prize money of equivalent value to the third prize will be given to the fifth prize winner.
- 12 In the event of a tie, the competitor with most 1<sup>st</sup> prizes will be adjudged the winner or the Judge's decision will be final.
